WHAT:

\$500 grants offered to public elementary schools for the purpose of presenting a school site character education initiative

WHEN:

Academic school year 2008-2009 with grant fund distribution to school site by September 26, 2008

PURPOSE:

to actively engage a school-site student population in the development and implementation of a character education project that involves students in (1) actions, (2) experiences and (3) group reflection to support the practice of an individual's responsibility, respect, integrity

GUIDELINES: The school site initiative ...

- is completed and submitted no later than April 25, 2008
- is conceived and developed by the Principal (or) a Classroom Teacher (or) a Grade-Level /Multi Grade Level Teacher Team with the leadership participation of a minimum of (3) students
- is developed as (1) a one-day character education event; or (2) a single or multi-classroom project; or (3) an on-going student activity involving one, some or all school site classrooms over a defined period of time, not exceeding 90 days
- must have school site student participation that involves a minimum of 30 students to a maximum of the entire school site student population
- may not be used to fund: (1) an all-school assembly; or (2) an existing PTSA program /event; or (3) the purchase of products for character education classroom curriculum and enhancements
