PURPOSE:

• to actively engage an elementary school-site in the development and implementation of a character education program/project that involves students in: (1) actions; (2) educational experiences and (3) group reflection to support the practice of one or more character virtues.

WHAT:

• \$250 grant is offered to an Orange County public or private elementary schools for the purpose of presenting a school site character education program/project in academic year Sept.2008-June,09. The grant is made available to each elementary school that: (a) fills out the 1-page grant application and (b) hosts a school site FINISH LINE Workshop presented by Passkeys Foundation that is attended by a minimum of 35 school site parents from the participating school.

WHEN:

• Grant funds distribution for academic school year Sept. 2008- June 2009: Within 2-weeks of the completion of the school site FINISH LINE Workshop.

GRANT GUIDELINES: The School Site Program/ Project...

- is developed by a school site team that *requires* the participation of the Principal and additionally *can include*:(a) specific grade-level teacher team; **or** (b) multi-grade level teacher team; **or** (c) school-wide teacher team **and/or** (d) school site parents are highly encouraged to participate with either (a) (b) or (c) teacher teams.
- is developed either as a: (1) one-day character education event; or (2) single or multi-classroom project; or (3) on-going student program involving one, some or all school site classrooms over a period of time defined by the school site grant team.
- has school site student participation involving a minimum of **50** students to a maximum of the total school site student population.
- may **not use** funds for: (1)an all-school assembly **or** (2) products for character education classroom curriculum and enhancements.
- may **use** funds to expand an existing school site character education program/project **if** the funds are used to expand and bring innovation to an existing program initiative. Grant funds may not be used simply to sustain funding support for an existing character education school site program/project.

GRANT APPLICATION SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

- The Grant Application is prepared and mailed to Passkeys Foundation within 30 days following the time of booking of the FINISH LINE Workshop
